

Steps to Working On Study Island For Math Lab

Study Island is a GREAT and IMPORTANT tool that students at Hoosier Academy have at their fingertips.

The program has several benefits:

- To prepare you for the Algebra End of Course Assessment that you have to pass to graduate high school.
- It will review/preview and work on skills from your regular course. (Pre-algebra and Algebra). If you have it mastered, it shouldn't take you long to prove your skills. On the other hand, it will also explain and help you work through those skills if you need extra help.

In Math Lab we are going to begin to use this tool as our weekly assignments. You will get a grade for completing the assignments each week. This will also be reflected to your homeroom teacher and your progress will count for the study island they require as well. This grade is still based on completion.


There are two ways to earn this grade:

1. Earn passports, an average of 70% questions answered correctly after ten questions, on **EACH** topic for the week.
2. Answer at least ten questions, and spend minimum of 15 minutes on **EACH** topic assigned.

My live sessions each week will go over the material from the assignment. Check out the class connect calendar to see what we will be going over each day. If you do not earn a passport for the topic please plan to attend.

1. Sign in at studyisland.com
 - a. Your Username is your student ID plus @havs
 - b. Your Password is havs, unless you have changed it.
 - c. If you can't login send me a kmail ASAP so I can help you with that.

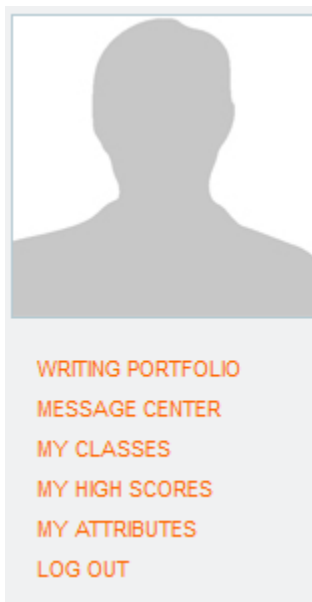

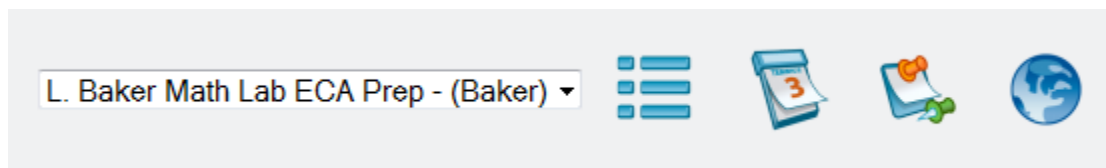
